

Registration/Check-in
Guidelines

1. Arrive at Knox Scout Reservation parking lot.
2. Send Pack Coordinator to the check-in area. (Note: *Packs must Register by October 1st for 1st weekend and by October 8th for the 2nd weekend.*)
3. Pack Coordinator provides updated pack & den rosters at check in.
4. After the Pack Coordinator has checked in, each family should proceed to Admin Building for check in and to get wristbands.
5. Camp set up, combine all pack equipment & personal gear into one vehicle. (All other vehicles must be parked in the main Parking Lot.)
6. Move one vehicle per pack into your campsite area and unload it. Continue process until all equipment is at campsite, then return vehicle to lot and the Pack Coordinator will return pass to the Admin Bldg. (Large Packs will be allowed a 2nd pass.)
7. Setup campsite. Space is limited; use only what you need. Please be courteous to your neighbors
8. Please follow the direction of all Staff & Traffic Coordinators. This will facilitate your getting checked in and to your campsite.
9. Updated information and schedules will be given to Pack Coordinator at Check-in.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Pack Coordinators: Contact the Council office for your unit's Leaders Guide & registration packet. Pack Coordinators will register their pack for this event. **Your pack's registration is due to Council no later than October 1st for 1st weekend and by October 8th for the 2nd weekend**. Late registrations may not be accepted.

Pack Coordinators should have a medical form for each Scout and family member. (A class 1 medical form is sufficient). You should have all medical forms attached to each Family Registration Form to turn into the Council when you register the Pack.

Parents: Registration is \$40.00 (includes T-shirts and Patches) for a Scout and one Adult Partner or \$30.00 without T-Shirts. Each additional Scout or family member (age 5 and older) is \$15 (You may purchase T-shirts or Patches, for \$12 (t-shirt) \$2 (patch) **Register with your Pack Coordinator.** They will consolidate pack registration information and money and submit registration package to the Council.

Camping and Parking

All cars will be parked in designated parking lots. Due to limited parking space, carpooling is encouraged. Please see Check-in and registrations guidelines page. **NO RIDERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BED OF TRUCKS OR TRAILERS.**

Camping will be by pack and in an assigned campsite. However due to the size and participation of this event, it may be necessary to combine packs within a campsite area. Please refrain from roping off your campsite area. The only exception would be a Pack's bow saw yard, if they choose to have one. Please **DO NOT** bring an axe, hatchet or chain saw to this event; only bow saws will be permitted.

Tent camping only, no campers or R.V.'s will be allowed in the campsites. Each unit is responsible for their own meals and equipment. Please be sure to bring containers for water.

Use of gas stoves and charcoal should follow BSA policies and guidelines.

Restrooms and shower facilities are available.

Pets, Boom boxes, two-way radios, guns fireworks, sheath knives, **PETS**, and alcoholic beverages are not allowed. All BSA and Georgia-Carolina Council campground policies must be followed.

Make sure all campfires are out before retiring for the night and before you check out. A fire check will be made and you will be awakened to extinguish the fire if no one is tending it.

Be prepared for the weather. Nights can get cold and rain is popular this time of the year. Pack accordingly. Event will run rain or shine!

According to the BSA guidelines. Each Tiger, Wolf, Bear, and Webelos must have a responsible adult family member or guardian accompany them to the Spook-o-ree.

Be sure to carry out your own trash; you can dispose of it at the camp designated trash dumpster as you leave.

THE LAKE WILL BE OFF LIMITS TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND STAFF.

Campsite gates will be closed during events. No vehicle will be allowed in while events are in session.
