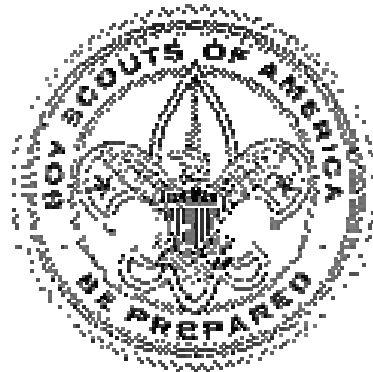

The 2009 Merit Badge University will be held on Saturday, February 7th, 2009 and is open to all Scouts at the rank of 1st Class and above. The University is designed to offer merit badges not typically available at Council events and that have likelihood to be completed within the time offered, if studious in your attempt.

The Merit Badge University cost \$10.00 which includes lunch and your class materials. Classes will be limited to 15 Scouts on a first-come, first served basis so it is important to register as early as possible. Pre-registration is required and must be received at the Scout office no later than Friday, January 16th, 2009.

The event location is yet to be determined and some merit badges may be offered at a remote site. Further instructions will be sent out to each registrant, preferably by e-mail, the week of January 27th, 2009.
