# Directions to Hamburg State Park

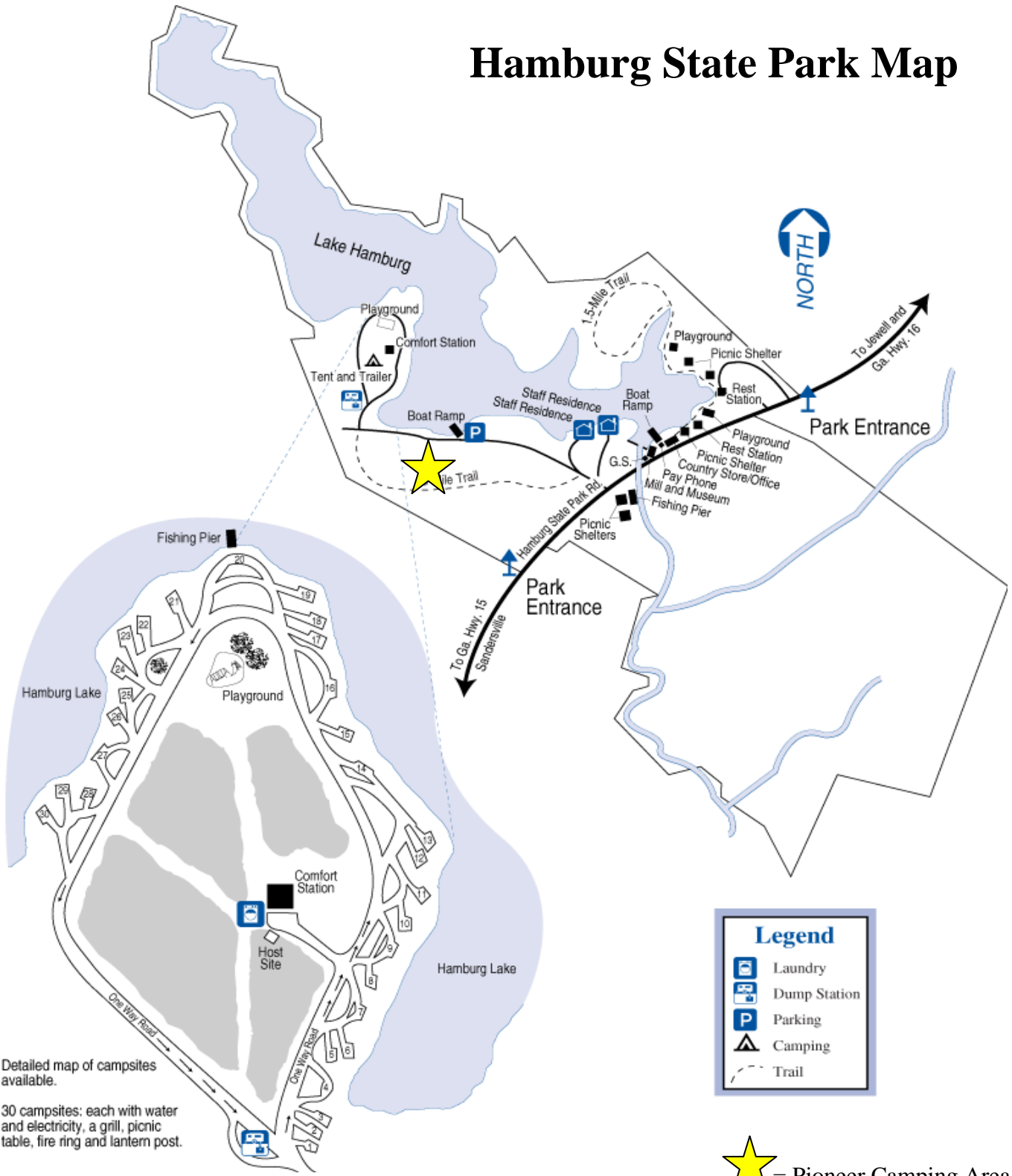
## From Aiken/Augusta/Evans/Martinez:

- Take I-20 West towards Atlanta. (~29 mi.)
- Take the GA-80 Exit, Exit 165, toward Camak / Warrenton (0.3 mi.)
- Turn Left onto GA-80/Washington Hwy. (7 mi.)
- Turn Right onto E. Main St./US-278/GA-12/ Jefferson Davis Hwy. (0.7 mi.)
- Turn slight Left onto Macon Hwy/GA-16 (8.8 mi.)
- Turn Left onto Shoals Rd/GA-123 (3.5 mi.)
- Turn Right onto Shoals Rd. (1.7 mi.)
- Turn Left onto GA-248/Hamburg State Park Rd. (2.8 mi.)
- End at 6071 Hamburg State Park Rd. Mitchell, GA 30820

## Directions from Waynesboro:

- Start out going South on Liberty Street towards 10<sup>th</sup> Street
- Turn Right onto W. 6<sup>th</sup> Street / GA-24/GA-56/GA-80/Peace St. (1.5 mi.)
- Turn slight Right onto GA-80 (23 mi.)
- Turn Left onto GA-80/GA-88/Broad St. Cont. to follow GA-80 (0.4 mi.)
- Stay straight to go onto GA-102 (23.5 mi.)
- Turn Right onto Agricola Rd./Hamburg-Agricola Rd/CR-111 (3.5 mi.)
- Turn Left onto Hamburg State Park Rd./Hamburg Rd./GA-248 (0.1 mi.)
- End at Hamburg State Park
