*This course is designed for those who work, play or live in areas 30 minutes or more from regular EMS response. The course combines classroom lecture, skills practice, and role-playing to teach the response steps and treatment of injuries and illnesses in a delayed-help situation. Learn to prioritize care and treat injuries in the field and to plan and carry out transports and evacuations.*

**Prerequisites:** American Red Cross Basic First Aid. If you do not have this, a course will be offered on Friday, March 20, 7:00pm – 9:30pm at MCG, Pavilion II (Building AF), Room 1002. Pavilion II is located on Laney Walker Blvd. between RA Dent & 15<sup>th</sup> Street on MCG’s campus. This course is **ONLY** available to those enrolled in the Wilderness First Aid Course. If you already have this, bring current certification card with you to check-in on Saturday. The minimum age to participate in the Wilderness First Aid course is 15.

**Course Certification:** Payment of the course fee is not a guarantee of certification. Your Wilderness First Aid Certificate is valid for 3 years. To be eligible for course certification you must:

- Be present for the entire course
- Successfully complete all required skills
- Pass a 50-question multiple choice written exam with a score of 80% or better

**Logistics:** Starts at 9am each day and lasts approx. 8 hours each day. Check-in at the Kiokee Shelter by 8:30am on Saturday. Bring all personal equipment (including personal First Aid Kit) you will need for the weekend, including food. **NO** meals will be provided. Camping Saturday night is available, but not mandatory, at Knox Scout Reservation.
