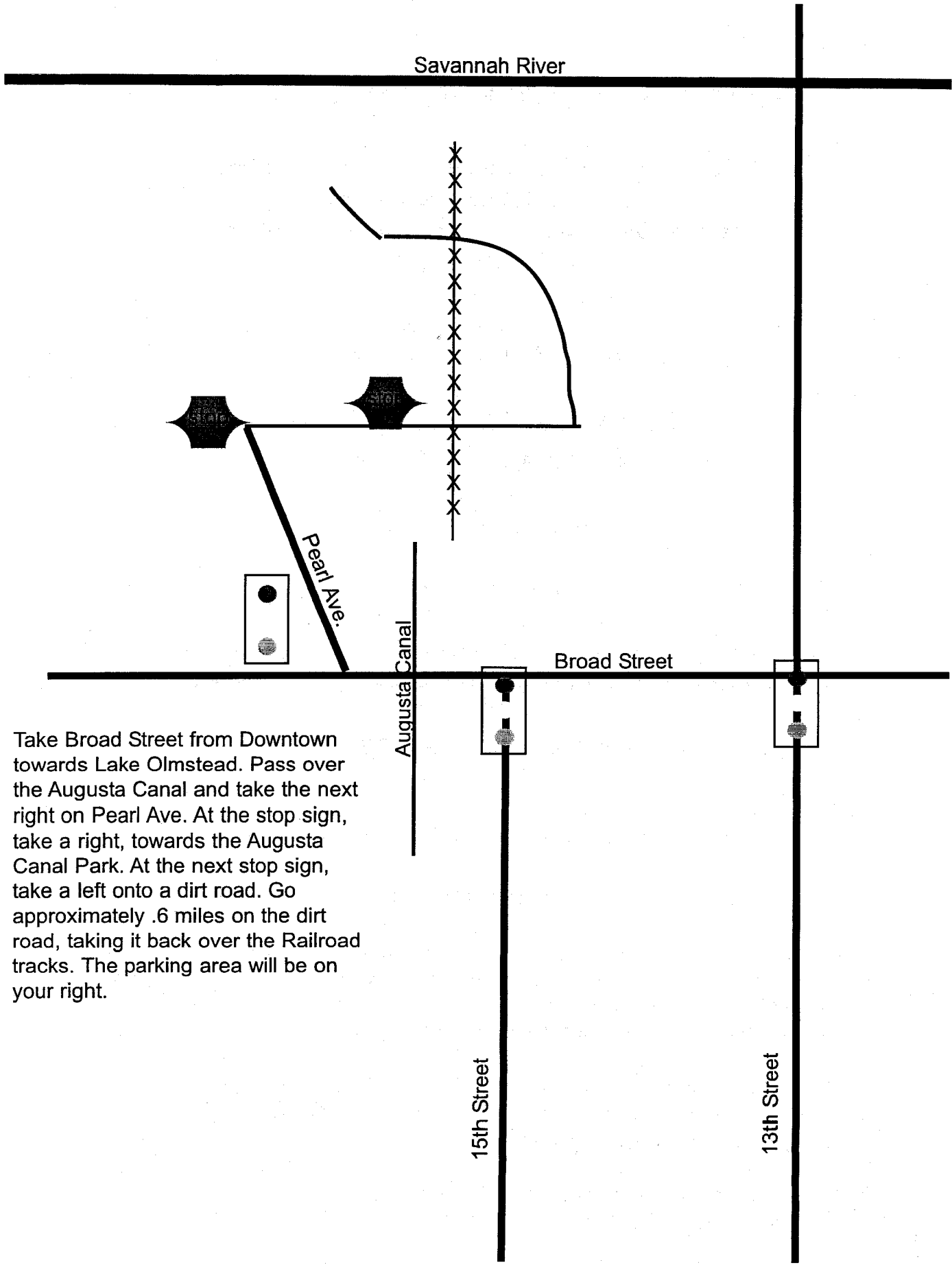

Take Broad Street from Downtown towards Lake Olmstead. Pass over the Augusta Canal and take the next right on Pearl Ave. At the stop sign, take a right, towards the Augusta Canal Park. At the next stop sign, take a left onto a dirt road. Go approximately .6 miles on the dirt road, taking it back over the Railroad tracks. The parking area will be on your right.
